1. Shitkalin Vastra Vitran Pariyojna:

Bhartiya Jan Vikas organization through its social responsibilities distributed woolen cloths to poor people in Delhi & NCR, Patna areas. The main focus and motive of this activity is to help poor and street people for to avoid cold impacts. Around 250 people covered under this program and all have been provided woolen cloths through dedicated volunteers.



2. Jan Jan Annapurna

Under this program Bhartiya Jan Vikas with its dedicated volunteers managed to organize food distribution camps. The main objective of this program was to provide food for physically challenged and poor people who belongs to streets and not able to earn enough to run their livelihood. With the efforts of our volunteers we manage to provide food to around 1000 and more people.



3. Corona ko hatana hai, desh ko bachana hai:

Under this noble program the organisation collected small donations from its volunteers and procured sanitizers, gloves and mask. All these collected items has been distributed to needful communities of poor background. These activities were completed without public gathering and maintaining social distancing.
